WHAT IS WAYMAKER INTERNATIONAL?

WayMaker was founded by Andy Robinson and registered as a charity in England and Wales (1199440) in June 2022.

As a result of Andy's Christian beliefs, the purpose of the charity is to share good news and make a way where there is no way by looking to relieve sickness and financial hardship, preserve good health and advance education in some of the poorest communities in the UK, Europe and the world.

OUR MISSION AND VISION

Our mission is to make a way where there is no way for the poor, sick, marginalised, uneducated, and displaced by mobilising a community committed to generating and sharing personal and corporate wealth to help balance an unbalanced world.

OUR INTERNSHIP

Our internship is unpaid, and you will be a WayMaker volunteer. The term of your internship will be 10 months and will begin in September 2024. It is expected to require two days a week. You will work with Andy, the Charity Founder, to create and edit videos and podcasts for social media and beyond. The role is hybrid, working from home and in the office when recording Andy for the various social media channels is necessary.

- Interns are expected to have experience with social media on (at least) a personal level (use on a business level preferred but not).
- Knowledge of digital media software Photoshop or other graphic design software, etc. is preferred but not essential.
- Knowledge of video editing software iMovie, Final Cut, or Windows Live Movie Maker is a plus.
- Knowledge of social media Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, YouTube, TikTok, blogs, etc.
- Willingness to create video blogs, write press releases and scripts with Andy and publish at least twice a week.
- Energy, with a desire to come up with fresh ideas on how to grow our online presence.
- Ability to build and communicate to an online community on social media.
- Responding on Andy's behalf to social media comments.
- Experience proofreading and editing.
- Ability to deal with uncertainty.
- Ability to contribute individually and participate together with others.

TRAINING: Training will be given as necessary to the right candidate if they lack these key skills.

TRAVEL: There may also be an opportunity to travel with Andy to the many places WayMaker operates, such as, but not limited to, Romania, Zambia, Kenya, Tanzania and, on occasion, the USA. If required to travel, then your travel, accommodation, and contribution to subsistence will be covered by WayMaker. These trips are usually one or two days if in the UK, or long weekends if in Europe and at least two weeks if in Africa or America.
